# Lioness in the Community Cannon County High School Woodbury, Tennessee

#### Introduction

The Lioness Club is an existing community service organization at Cannon County High School, affiliated with the local Lions Club. The club is seeking to increase community involvement and



improve the local community by developing a specific project for each month of the year, each involving a different community partner. Club members and sponsors will work with community representatives to determine needs in the organizations.

## **Essential Questions**
